



Book in a Box Project



Please try to use as many recyclable materials as you can!

Step 1

To begin with you need to choose a book and read it to ensure that you understand it well. This can be a book that you have read before and really enjoyed, or it could be a new, more challenging book.

Step 2

After choosing and reading a book, you must select a book report container. The container could be a plastic bag, an envelope, a can, or anything else that might be appropriate for a book. Once you have chosen your container, you then need to decorate it to convey some of the major details, elements, or themes found in the book.

Step 3

You now need to work on the contents of your containers! You must include the following:

Questions

Your container needs to contain some questions about your book. These could be simple questions or questions that require a deeper level of thinking. E.g. Who is the main character? What is the book about? On page 8 Ben is crying, what has happened to make Ben feel like this?

Vocabulary

Create a glossary of unfamiliar or powerful vocabulary from the book.

Things

Try to include five things that have a connection to the story – these are going to be used during Show and Tell time in Transition Week.

Step 4

The final part of your project is to create a poster that can be shared with the class. In the poster you must:

- Explain the connection of the container to the story;
- Conduct a show and tell about your five objects;
- Share information about three of the book's literary elements – setting, characters, conflicts, climax or resolution.
