

## Home Learning Project – Design a Theme Park!

The theme is careers and enterprise and a different type of task – something we would like to do at the end of term!

### START HERE:

1. Take the quiz on <https://icould.com> to remind yourself of what kind of job you would like to do and the skills you might need. Are you a panda? A dolphin?
2. Research some of the jobs you like the look of – you may not have even heard of some of the jobs that are out there! Can you make a list of the different jobs you find interesting? Include what skills, qualifications you need.

### Design a Theme Park – and think about how to make a profit!

We have included PowerPoints to think about how you would set a budget, work out ticket prices, menus, adverts and even how to design a rollercoaster! Will your theme park have a theme: Disney? Universal Studios? Or many but general but with themed areas like Alton Towers?

**Start with PPT 1.** You will need to think about the layout of your theme park. What will you include? Have you got space? Can you afford it? What 'extras' will make you money? Thrill rides cost more than children's rides so think about how to spend your budget – will people come if you only have two big rides?

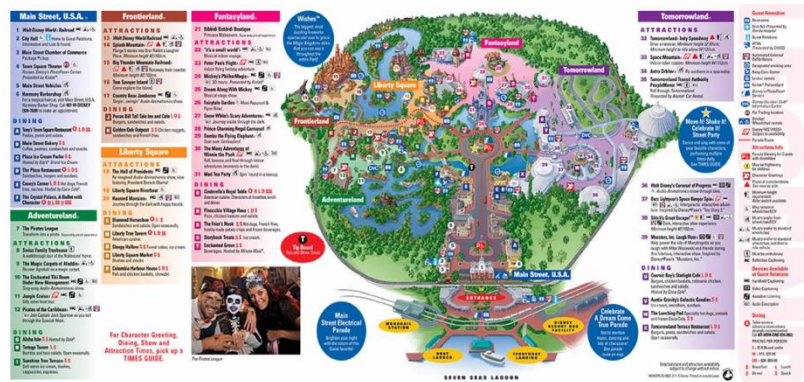
We have included budget sheets – like a real business – to help you understand the costs of running a business. You can plan out your theme park using the grid sheet.

### PPT 2 Let your customers know what is in the park – design a park map.

Think about what to include: the location of the big rides – make your park sound exciting!

Remember people also need to know the basics – toilets, first aid and lost and children.

Also, the gift shop and food places so you can make even more money. Your map will need to be easy to read and clearly set out.



### PPT3 You will need some visitors to your theme park!

Design your advert – a TV advert or a poster for your theme park. We have included a magazine advert to give you ideas and an example for Alton Towers. Make sure, that whatever you write, it is persuasive! Especially if your ticket prices are high!

**OR** You could also design a food menu - healthy or fast food? What will you charge?

You could write a job description or an advert for your employees – what kind of people do you need? What skills? Think about how they will be dealing with customers all day.
