GO 4 SCHOOLS

The school uses a powerful, joined-up on-line paperless system which enables staff, pupils and parents/carers to view academic information in real time. This is an easy and efficient way of working and saves time logging in to multiple systems.

By using GO 4 Schools, you will be able to view your child's progress online and access the following information at any time:

- **Attainment information** – Marks and target grades for all subjects throughout the year
- **Timetable** – Your child's daily and weekly timetable
- **Attendance** – Shown from the start of the academic year
- **Progress Reports** – Full written reports which are published three times a year

Your child's page is constantly updated, providing you with the latest information (*updates occur overnight and not all of the above will be visible from the start of the academic year*).

These are the basic instructions for entering the site:

- for Go 4 Schools: <https://www.go4schools.com/parents> (there is also a link to this page on the homepage of the Academy website)
- Click on 'First-time User?' (about half way down the screen)
- In the box which appears on the screen, enter the email address you have registered with the Academy (the email address where you receive emails with letters attached from the Academy)
- Click on 'New Password'
